Qualified Applicants: Undergraduate students majoring in astronomy, physics, chemistry, electrical engineering, computer science, or any related topics on science and engineering. All applicants will be considered, but students that are starting their 3rd/4th year or are starting a Master's degree are preferred.

Period for Application: February 18 – March 15, 2019

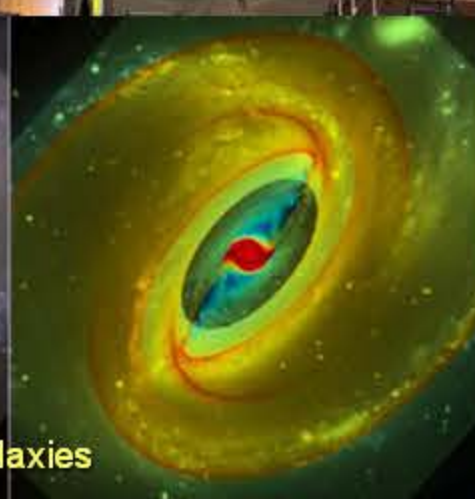
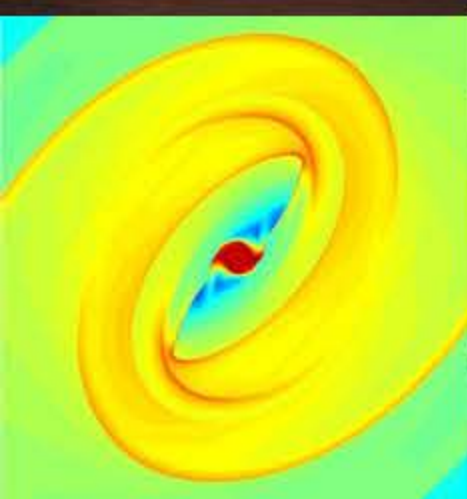
